Report

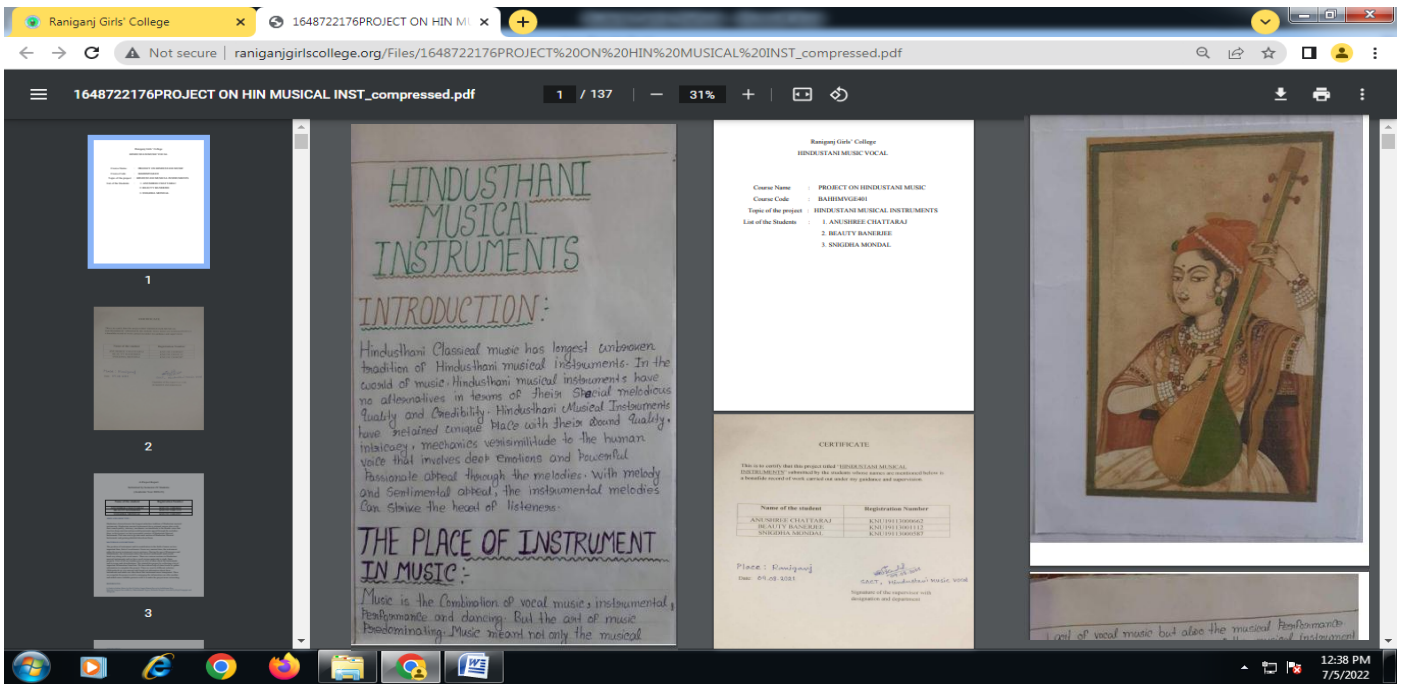
Aims and Objective of the project:
 Coal mining activities and functioning of a number of medium-scale industries like sponge iron, cement, brick, thermal power etc. have adversely affected the environmental health of Raniganj Coalfield area as a whole. Occurrence of air borne diseases has become a common ailment of the inhabitants of this area. indiscriminate open air burning of coal by the local inhabitants for cooking as well as cooking purposes and vehicular traffic also have considerable contribution to the high concentration of pollutants in this area.
 The aim of our project was to investigate the contributory effect industrial development on the air quality and its consequent impact on human health of Raniganj Coalfield area.

Materials and Methods used:
 Field visits were conducted at different factories and collieries to collect emission data. Visit to different hospital, nursing homes and health centres were carried out to survey the health status of the people suffering from respiratory and other pulmonary diseases. The whole survey was completed in three weeks during the month of December, 2020.

Conclusion:
 Industrial growth and its product as pollution are increasing day by day. This has been causing adverse consequences on human health. Particulate matter and gaseous emission from industries are responsible for rising discomfort, increasing airway diseases, decreasing productivity and causing deterioration of environment. Major pollutants from sponge iron industries and coal mining industries include SPM, smoke, carbon monoxide and other poisonous gases and solid wastes. The pollution zones have been identified and health data has been collected accordingly. People have been found to suffering from respiratory problems. The results depict a clear correlation between health problems and level of pollutants.

- Introduction:** A novel coronavirus (CoV) named '2019-nCoV' or 2019 novel coronavirus or COVID-19 by WHO is in charge of the current outbreak of pneumonia that began at the beginning of Dec, 2019 near in Wuhan city, China. Being considered as pandemic, it has reached more than 120 nations, when compared to SARS influenza, it has higher rate of fatality and without vaccine and vaccination. Though related to SARS, but the fatality rate is higher in older ages and for males in comparison to SARS.
- Coronavirus Structure:** A diagram shows the structure of a coronavirus with labels: Spike (S), Membrane (M), Nucleocapsid (N), and RNA genome.
- Structure:** CoV of the family coronaviridae are enveloped, positive-sense single-stranded RNA viruses. It's genome comprises 24 open reading frames (ORF) and three of which encode 16 non-structural proteins (NSP) that make up the replicase complex. The remaining one third encodes nine accessory proteins (ORF) and four structural proteins (S, envelope (E), membrane (M), and nucleocapsid (N)) of which spike mediates SARS-CoV entry into host cells.
- Transmission and Pathogenesis of Covid-19:** The binding of a receptor expressed by host cells is the first step of viral infection followed by fusion with the cell membrane. It is reasoned that the lung epithelial cells are the primary target of the virus. It has been reported that human to human transmissions of SARS-CoV occurs by the binding between the receptor-binding domain of virus spike and the cellular receptor which has been identified as angiotensin-converting enzyme 2 (ACE2) receptor.
- Pathogenicity & Life cycle:** The main pathogenesis of Covid-19 infection of a respiratory system targeting virus was severe pneumonia, BNAemia, combined with incidences of group-glass opacities, and acute cardiac injury. A higher infected with COVID-19 showed higher leukocyte numbers, abnormal respiratory findings, and increased levels of plasma pro-inflammatory cytokines.
- Diagnosis:** A flowchart shows the diagnostic process: Clinical symptoms (Fever, Cough, Shortness of breath, Fatigue, Loss of taste and smell) and Lab diagnosis (RT-PCR, Serology, Microscopy, Culture) leading to COVID-19.
- Microbiological measures for its prevention:** Wash hands with alcohol based hand wash/soap/water, Maintain atleast 1.5m distance while interacting, Don't touch your nose, hand or ears, Wear mask while you sneeze or cough, preferably with your bent elbow or tissue, Try to find early medical attention, if you have fatigue, cough and trouble breathing, Use sanitizers to sterilize your hands.
- Treatment:** Vaccines are designed to protect people they are exposed to a virus in this case SARS-CoV-2. A vaccine basically trains the immune system to recognize and attack a virus, even one it hasn't seen before. While vaccines indicate an infection, they almost never cause illness. Various drugs are being given to the patients: Remdesivir-over 12 years of age (Sotrovimab (casirivimab/imdevimab)) High risk patients, 2-deoxy-D-glucose (developed by DRDO).
- Conclusion:** The transmission of novel COVID-19 is increasing with an unexpected speed for humans to humans around the world. Notably, mode of transmission contributes to accelerating the spreading of COVID-19 which may assist a scientist to discover effective therapeutic measures. In this pandemic situation.

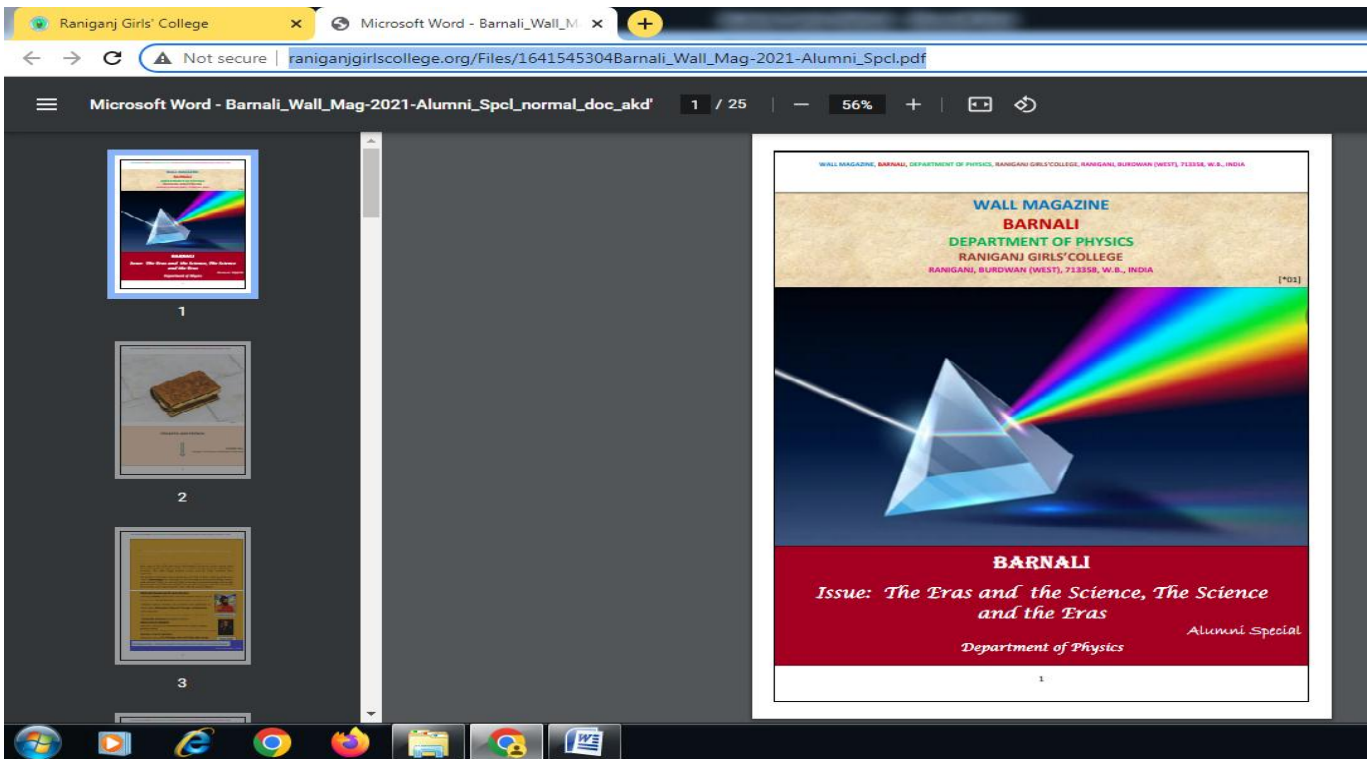
Problems and Prospects of Handloom Industry in India

1. Introducing the Handloom Industry:
The textile industry is the largest industry of modern India. This industry holds a unique position in terms of providing huge employment, contributing a significant portion of country's GDP and earning of foreign exchange. This industry classified into two broad segment- unorganised sector and organised sector. The unorganised sector includes handloom, handicrafts, sericulture, powerloom and the organised sector includes spinning, garmenting, made-up, cotton mills, etc. Handloom weaving is the largest cottage industry in India. It is a micro-scale industry as per the definition of Govt. of India because its capital is limited up to Rs. 50 lacs. It provides huge employment opportunities to the people mainly in the rural area in India. It is the second largest economic activity after agriculture in India. It holds its supreme tradition and expresses the cultural diversity of India. Indian handloom product like *Muslin*, *Tanzori*, *Baluchari*, have been recognised in all over the world and these are very popular for their uniquely designs, fineness, colour combination

2. Origin of Handloom Industry:
Weaving of fragmented cotton and bone needles was discovered at *Mohenjo-daro* and *Harappa*, the ancient seats of the Indus Valley civilization. The Indian tradition of craft of weaving started from time immemorial and was also mentioned in the *Rigveda* and in the epics of *Mahabharata* & *Ramayana*. There were a special class of community known as *Ganvati* (weavers). They were masters of their crafts who produced fabulous semi-transparent high quality uniquely designed sarrees. Demand of this high quality sarrees did spread all over the world. Indian sarrees (cotton & silk) were exported in huge quantities for the Romans because the Roman women liked this quality sarree very much. China & Indonesia were the other importers of the Indian sarrees. These uniquely designed sarrees were also exported to Europe and Far East before the entry of the British East India Company.
The heritage of Indian culture has been very much demonstrated by the Indian handloom industry. It holds a very high tradition of excellence in making high quality, uniquely designed, fine sarrees. Hand-spun cotton cloth was very popular

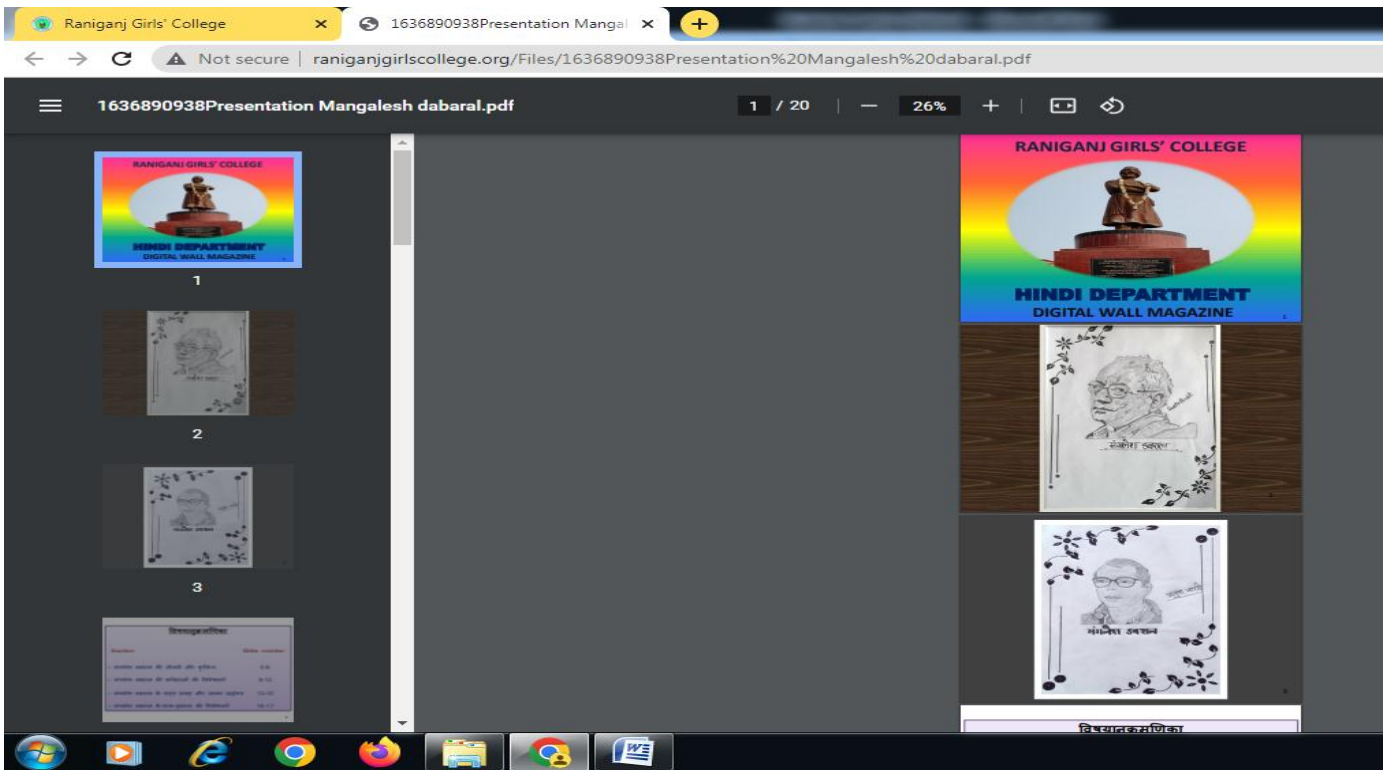

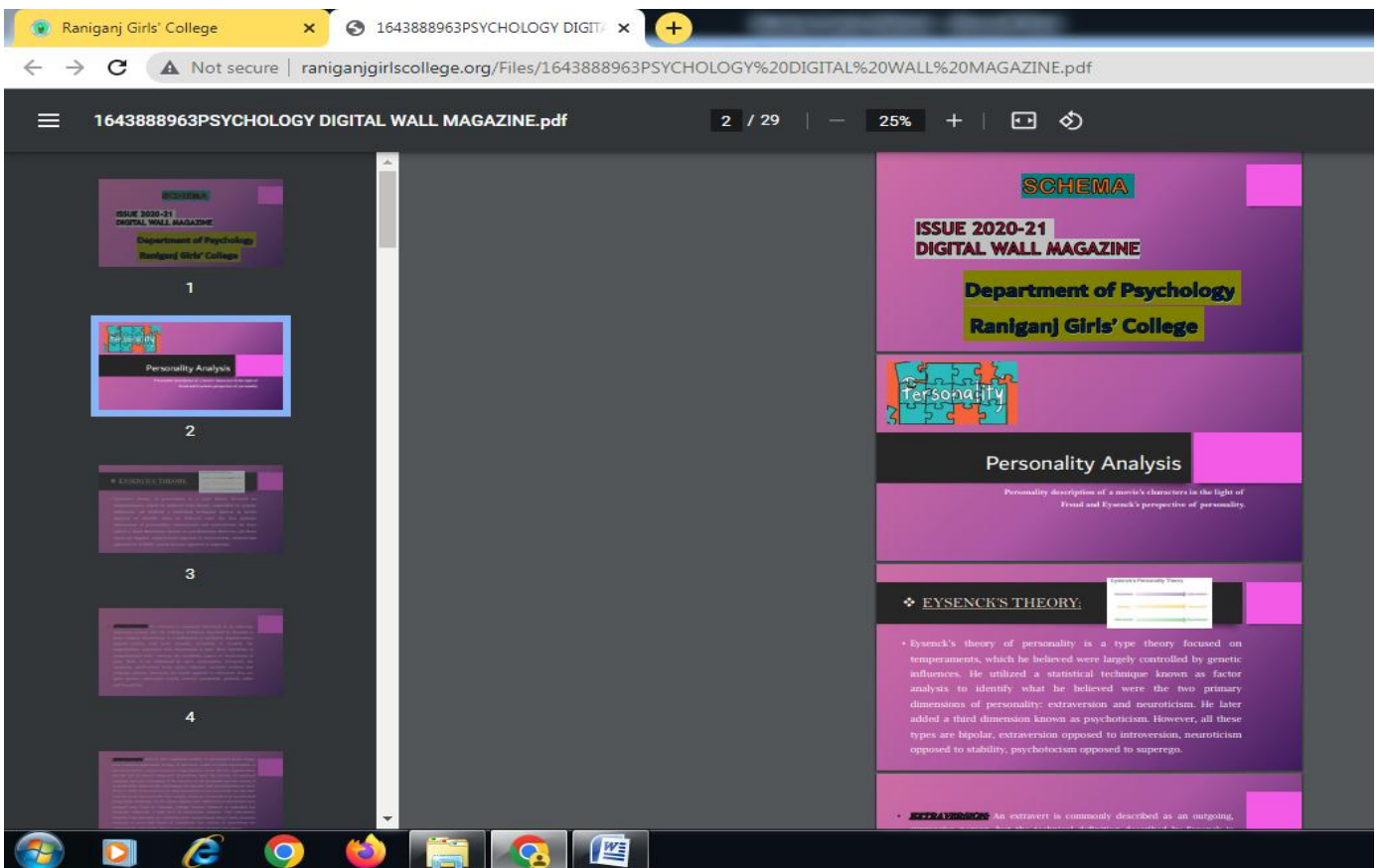

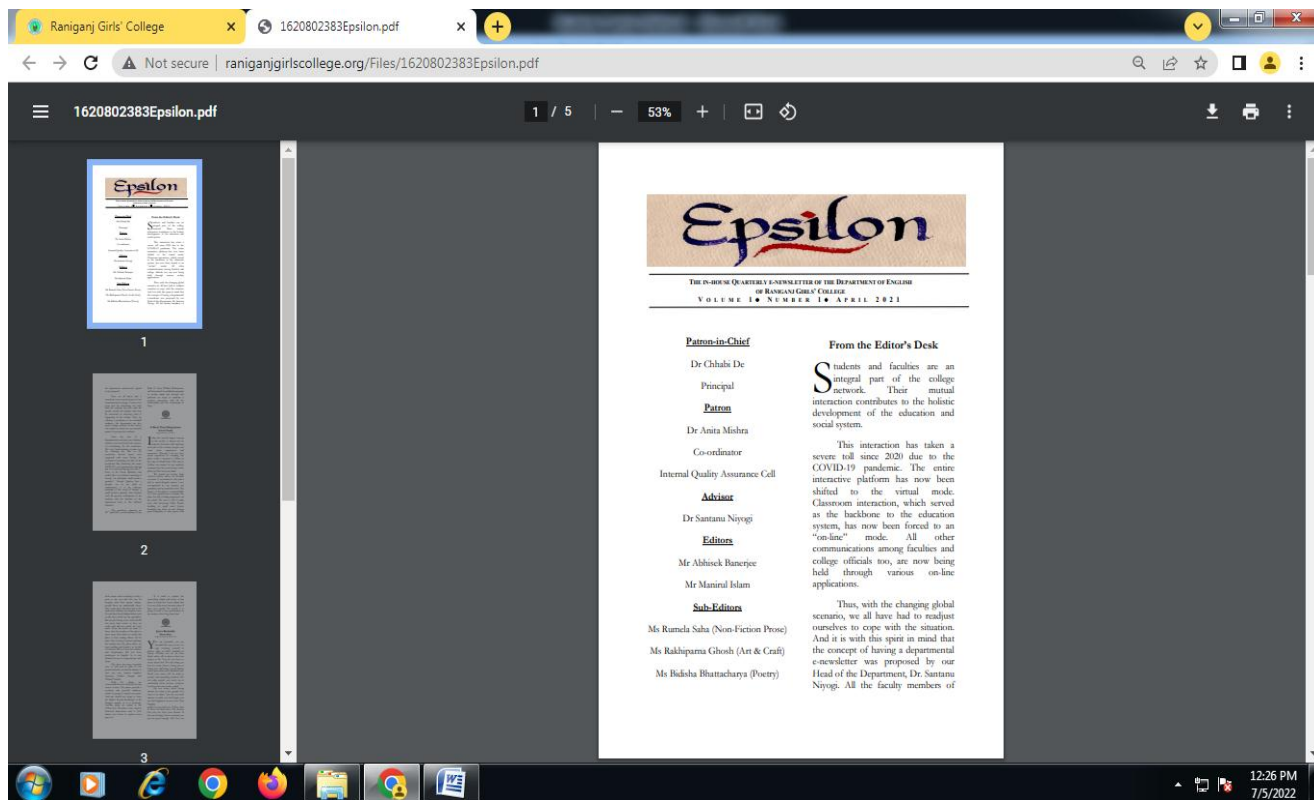
