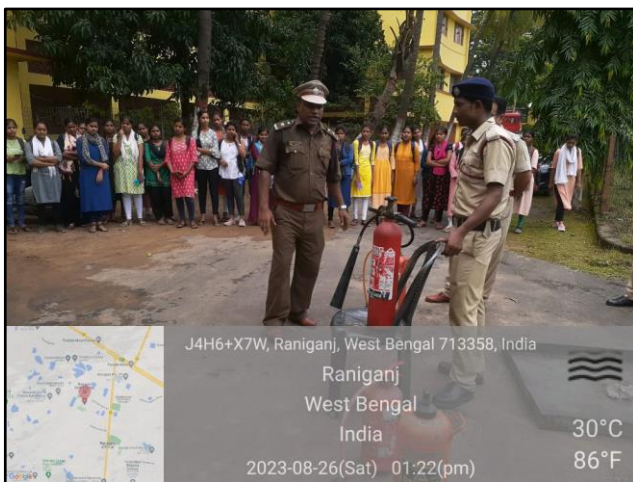

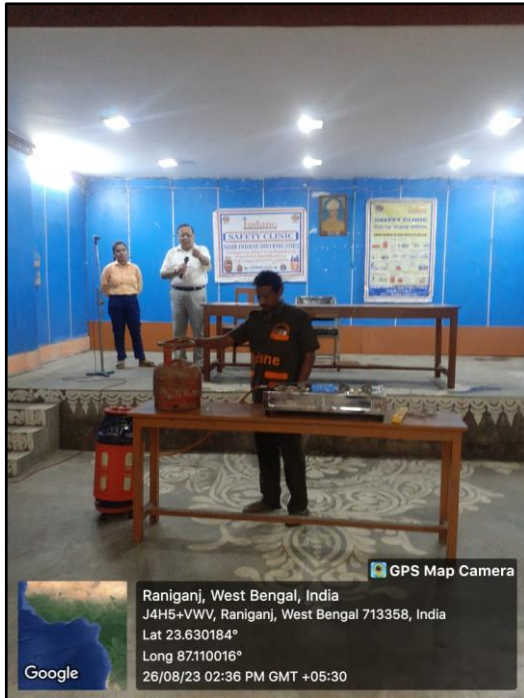
Programme 2: Training in Elementary Fire Safety Measures

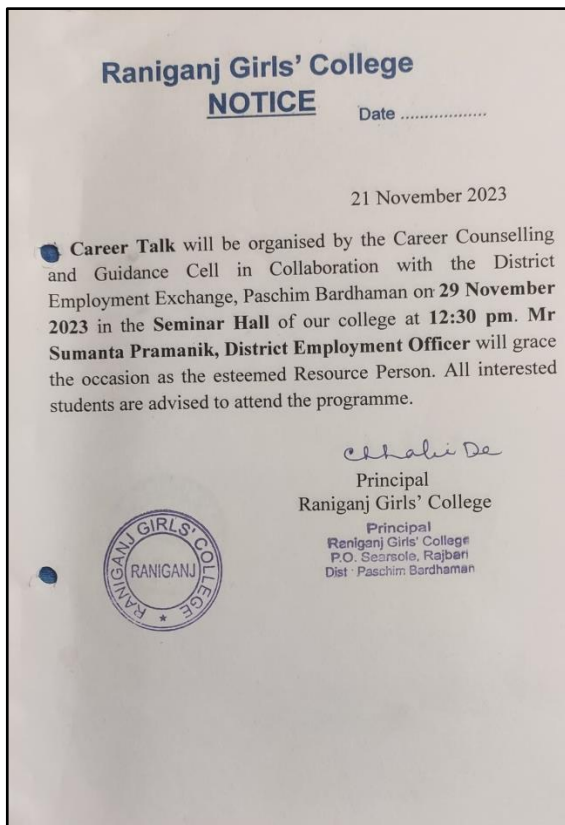
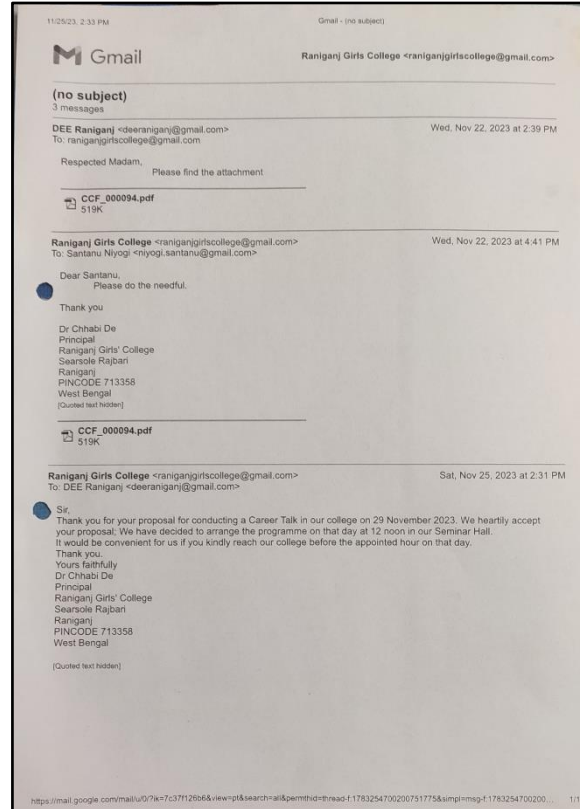
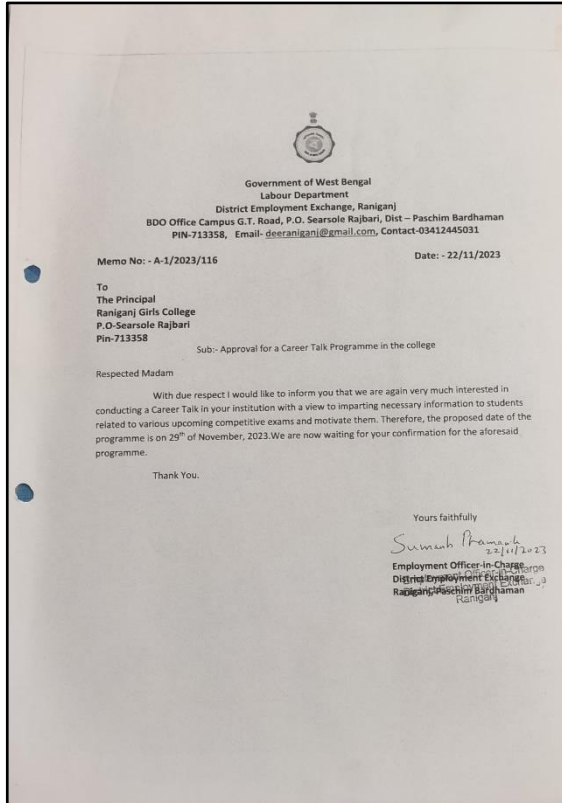
Programme 3: Training in Safe Handling of LPG

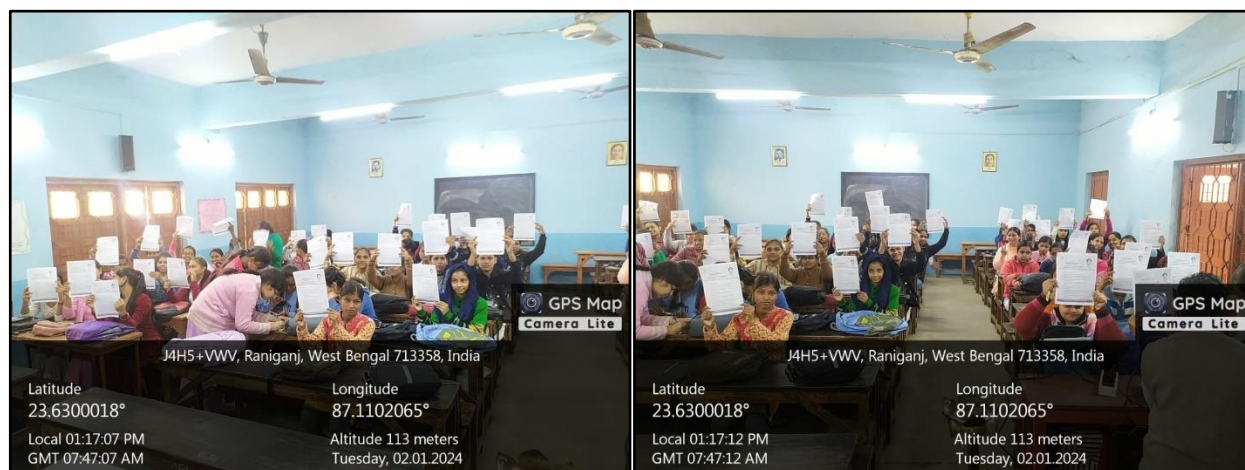
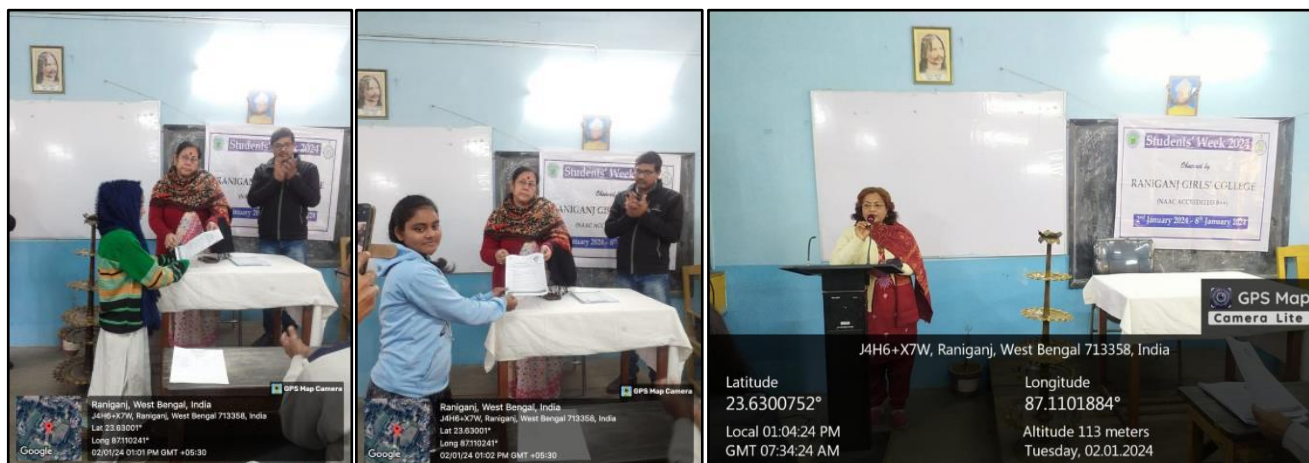


Programme 5: Hands on Workshop on Creation of ABC (Academic Bank of Credit) ID organized by Raniganj Girls' College
